Skyline Swimmer Code of Conduct

All Skyline swimmers are responsible for abiding by the following rules:

- Behavior that endangers another swimmer or disrupts practices or meets will not be tolerated.
- Swimmers are expected to treat coaches, officials and teammates with respect at all times.
- 3. Swimmers shall treat the pool facility and team equipment with respect.
- No running or horseplay on deck, in the water, or in the bathrooms.
- 5. No foul language will be tolerated.
- Adhere to the rules and regulations of all the pools.

Any infraction of the above will be dealt with by the coach, as follows:

- The coach may either give the swimmer a verbal warning, or enact immediate suspension depending on the severity of the infraction.
- If there is a second occurrence, the coach will either contact the parents and seek their assistance, or enact an immediate and indefinite suspension.
- If a suspension is implemented without dismissal, the parents will be informed of the details of the suspension.
- A swimmer may be indefinitely suspended or dismissed from the team based on the severity of the violation. No fees will be refunded to dismissed members.
